About the Speaker:

Pete Earley is best-known for his nonfiction book, *CRAZY: A Father's Search Through America's Mental Health Madness*, which was one of two finalists for the 2007 Pulitzer Prize. His book has won awards from the American Psychiatric Association, the National Alliance on Mental Illness, Mental Health America, and prompted CNN to name him one of nation's top "Mental Wellness Warriors."

Earley has testified five times before the U.S. Congress about the need for mental health reform. He serves on a mental health advisory panel that advises Congress, writes a weekly mental health blog and is a regular contributor to *The Washington Post* editorial page about mental health issues. He is the author of 21 books, including five national best sellers.
